ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee grants recognition to **National Institute of Teacher Education, Khetri, Kamrup - 782403 (Assam)** for B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60 (sixty) students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. The institution shall appoint 6 teaching staff and supporting staff possessing the qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, before the commencement of the academic session 2000-2001 in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. The institution shall shift to its permanent building within a period of one year, if temporarily housed elsewhere.
3. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the NCTE norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, being unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should Inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 8 above.

If National Institute of Teacher Education, Khetri, Kamrup - 782403 (Assam) contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution should send a compliance report by 31st December, 2000 to ERC, NCTE.

Order

In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 National Institute for Teacher Education, Khetri, Kamrup, Assam, Pin – 782 403 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course of One year duration with an additional annual intake of 140 (one hundred forty) from the academic session 2003-2004.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3.00 lakhs.
- iv) The institution has selected the Principal and seven teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the affiliating University.


3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **National Institute for Teacher Education, Khetri, Kamrup, Assam, Pin – 782 403** for B.Ed. Course of one year duration from the academic session **2004-2005** with an additional annual intake of **40 (forty)**, thus with a total intake of 100 (one hundred) students subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a) That the institution will ensure that Principal and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- c) The library facilities, laboratory conditions and IT facilities to be strengthened and a report to this effect shall be sent to the ERC, NCTE before commencement of the course.
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


